

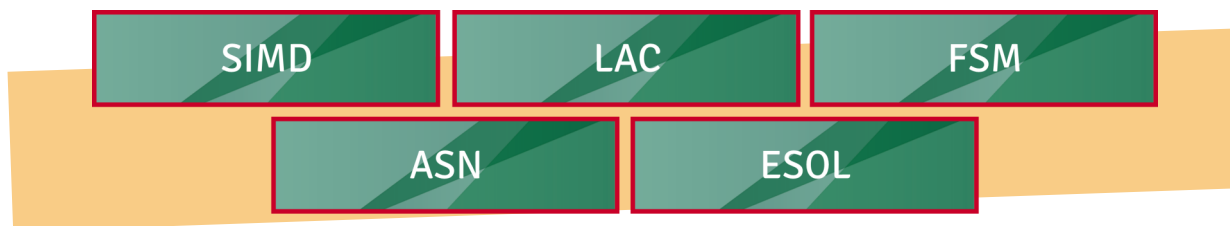
In order to target LIFT OFF support to individual pupils within each school, a robust pupil selection tool has been developed which uses data already held by schools themselves.

This selection method has been developed and piloted by LIFT OFF and Angus Council in session 2017/18 and is now being rolled out to all LIFT OFF target schools in all regions for session 2018/19.

### **CRITERIA:**

Firstly, LIFT OFF Core Pupils will be targeted by their potential to achieve at least two Highers by the end of S6—allowing that young person to apply to HE (HNC or above). This allows LIFT OFF to work with the pupils who align best with our operational targets. To determine this, MIDYIS/CAT scores can be used to determine a pupil's academic ability.

Once this initial measure has been confirmed, additional factors will then be considered to determine whether a pupil is eligible to receive additional support. These include, in no particular order:



All of the above indicators are held on SEEMIS—or local authority equivalent.

After a list of pupils who qualify based on the academic and personal indicators, local knowledge can then be used to support the inclusion/withdrawal of pupils from the original raw data list. Factors that schools may wish to consider are:



Once all pupils who meet these criteria are in the final list and the whole school quota has not been reached, LIFT OFF will then accept applications from pupils who make the academic criteria but do not make any personal indicators outlined above.
